Jordans Film Club

One of the ideas which came out of the survey carried out by JVL last year was that there was an opportunity for the Village to have its own Film Club. There is certainly plenty of scope to improve the utilisation of the Hall. The launch of the pop up pub, the Jolly Quaker, has been an outstanding success and has demonstrated that the residents of the Village are keen to develop a modern sense of community – a concept which has been an essential part of the Village since its birth nearly 100 years ago.

The idea is one thing but to actually get a Film Club running requires effort, initiative and a number of committed volunteers to make it a reality. The Village is lucky that we have one Resident, David Wooster, who is in the film business, and who decided to lend his experience and expertise to get it off the ground.

So far, it has been decided that we would pull together a small group of people to work together over the next 3 months for a launch in September. Between September and December, during a Pilot period, we would aim to show 4 films. At the end of that time, a

decision would be made to continue the Club – or close it, dependent on the response.




