

## 15 mph speed limit effective 1st May 2025

As part of an initiative to improve road safety for residents, their children and their pets, a new 15 mph speed limit comes into effect on all of the roads within JVL's Estate from 1st May 2025.

New signs have been erected at the entrance to the village, and each household within the estate will be issued with two new stickers, one to be affixed to your black wheelie bin, and the other to your blue wheelie bin.

Please support this initiative and keep to the lower limit. We would be grateful if you can speak to any delivery drivers visiting your home such as postal services or food delivery drivers and ask them politely to keep to the new speed limit.

JVL is planning some more speed humps around the village to ensure speeds are kept down and will install them over the next few years to spread the cost.

A BAR, and BBQ will be open all afternoon and evening and pre-ordered BREAKFAST can be bagged up for you in the Village Shop.




