JVHT will be holding its Annual General Meeting at 8 pm on 23rd October in the Village Hall.

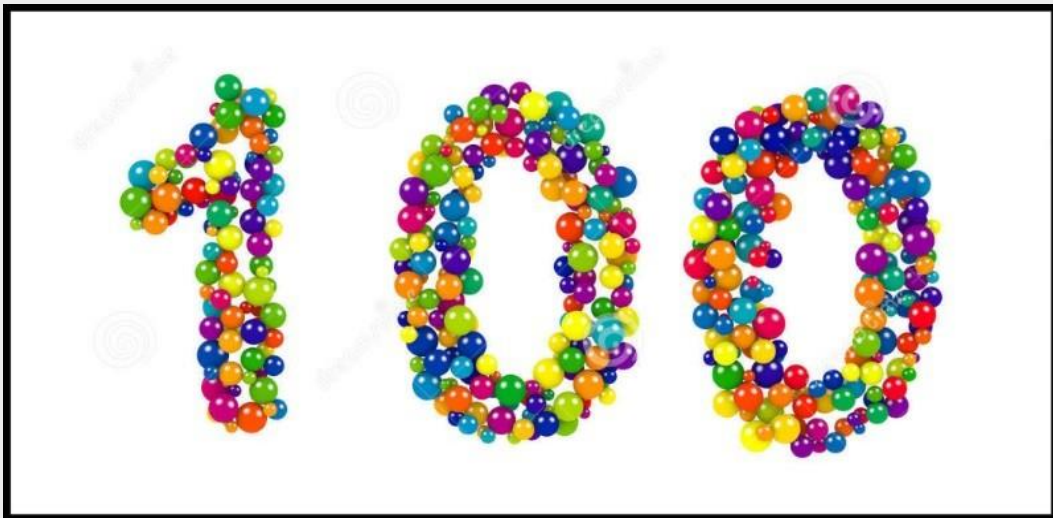
We will be asking Members of the Trust to approve the Annual Report and elect Trustees as necessary.

## Jordans Village Bus Stop

Most of you probably know that Jordans Village has a bus stop, but for those who don't it is located by the Estate Office. Carousel Buses run route 580 through Jordans twice a week, on

## Tuesdays and Fridays.

This route connects Beaconsfield to Uxbridge, via Seer Green, Chalfont St Giles, Chalfont St Peter, Gerrards Cross and Denham. It's ideal for a quick morning trip to Beaconsfield and back, leaving Jordans at 9:48am and returning from Beaconsfield at around midday.
