

# Sarah Green MP Visits Jordans

I greatly enjoyed holding a "Meet Your MP" event in Jordans at the end of August. I like to hold these informal drop-in events in some of our smaller communities to make myself available to any villagers who would like to come along and say hello - or ask a question, or raise a concern.

It was lovely to meet so many residents of Jordans face to face. Some of the topics raised included local issues, such as the state of our local rivers and the health of the chalk streams, and gas supply pipes in the local area, but also featured discussions about school breakfast clubs, adjustments for SEND students in school tests, international conflicts in Gaza and Ukraine, and global warming.

I will of course be following up many of these in future Parliamentary work. For example, I recently became the Vice Chair of the All Party Parliamentary Group on Ukraine. And on chalk streams, I will shortly be reintroducing a Bill to Parliament to try to secure legal protections from pollution and abstraction for these precious and globally rare ecosystems.

Jordans Village Performs (JVP) is happy to announce its next season of concerts for local people to enjoy. Jordans Village Performs is a community-run venture for local people in Seer Green and Jordans. We put on accessible concerts with a mix of classical and other music in Jordans Village Hall where there is a wonderful Yamaha concert-standard piano for performances – see pictures below. Music ranges from virtuoso piano and violin to accordion, oboe, flute, double bass with mostly classical but folk and other styles mixed in. The performers announce their pieces and explain how they work; the emphasis is on communication and conviviality. Children are welcome, and drinks are served in the interval.
